



### 12. Have you volunteered for a trail day in the past 3 years?





















26. While recreating on trails in Whatcom County, do you visit other types of businesses?





# 28. When recreating on trails in Whatcom County, do you ever stay for a night or longer?







### 30. Can you estimate your typical spend amount when in Bellingham / Whatcom County for a mountain bike ride, hike or trailrun?










